CURRICULUM & ASSESSMENTS

Stockdale Elementary uses high quality curriculum that supports student success. Our guiding document for all curriculum is the TEKs Resource System. In addition, we use the following resources to provide high quality instruction for our students:

We regularly assess our students to check for mastery of concepts, growth, and targeted areas of instructional need. Some of the assessments used include:

- STAAR Beginning of Year, STAAR Interim, and STAAR Summative tests
- MCLASS Benchmarks at beginning, middle, and end of year
- Circle Benchmark testing (beginning, middle, and end of year)
- Participation in the Texas Through Year Assessment Program (TTAP)
- Renaissance AR Math and Reading
- IXL Math Assessment
