
Dear Commissioner Morath,

The Stockdale ISD Board of Trustees approved and adopted the District of Innovation Plan on April 10, 2017. The timeline was as follows:

- January 9, 2017, Stockdale ISD Board of Trustees adopted a “resolution to consider designation as district of innovation”.
- February 6, 2017, public hearing was held to consider designating Stockdale ISD as a district of innovation.
- February 6, 2017, Stockdale ISD Board of Trustees appointed an innovation plan committee.
- February 13, 2017, first innovation plan committee meeting was held.
- February 27, 2017, second innovation plan committee meeting was held.
- February 28, 2017, proposed plan was reviewed by school attorney.
- March 3, 2017, Proposed Stockdale ISD Innovation Plan was posted to www.stockdaleisd.org website for at least 30 days.
- April 5, 2017, DEIC committee held a public meeting to consider the final version of the proposed plan. The committee voted unanimously to approve the plan.
- April 10, 2017, Stockdale ISD Board of Trustees approved and adopted the plan, effective July 1, 2017 until July 30, 2021.

The two enclosures include the final District of Innovation Plan for Stockdale ISD as well as a list of approved exemptions listed on Figure: 19 TAC §102.1307(d).
