Board of Trustees of the Stockdale Independent School District held a regular meeting on Monday, December 13, 2021.

Call to order at 6:30 p.m.

President Teri Wolff reserved the right to call a short recess if deemed necessary. She advised all present to refrain from the use of tobacco products on the school grounds and during the meeting. Business Manager Becky Stewart reviewed the current Financial Reports and Stockdale ISD bills provided to the Board, and answered questions concerning the reports.

Mr. Fuller made a recommendation to accept the monetary donation in the amount of \$300.00 for a Junior High Drama Club. A motion was made by Craig Clancy to accept the recommendation and seconded by Tanner Voelkel. The motion passed unanimously.

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Mr. Fuller made a recommendation to nominate David Deason to the Wilson County Appraisal District Board of Directors as the Stockdale Representative. A motion was made by Blaine Akin to accept the recommendation and was seconded by Barry Osborne. The motion passed unanimously.
